Statement of Rights and Beliefs

Action for More Independence and Dignity in Accommodation (AMIDA)

- 1. All people should live in the community, not institutions.
- 2. Everyone, whether disabled or not, has the right to choose where they live, with whom they live and the type of building they live in.
- 3. Everyone, whether disabled or not, has the right to live in places which are normal, good quality housing for that community.
- 4. All different types of housing should be decent and affordable.
- 5. Everyone has the right to an adequate level of income.
- 6. Everyone has the right to the opportunities and skills necessary to grow as much as they want to.
- 7. Everyone has the right to opportunities and skills for a variety of satisfying work.
- 8. Everyone has the right to opportunities to make friends and have normal support from friends and to decide how much involvement they want with the community around them.
- 9. Everyone has the right to control the services which they use.
- 10. Everyone has the right to use all community services if they wish to do so, and the right to any assistance needed to help them use such services.
- 11. Everyone has the right to spare time, and to do what they want with it.
